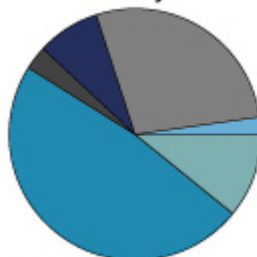

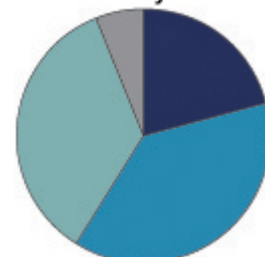
Who Attends SEPG?
